NOTES FOR COMPLETING THE APPLICATION:

- 1. - 5. <u>Commanding Officer</u> should review the Cadet's application for thoroughness and accuracy with regards to the Cadet's activities.

- 7. Applications must be received no later than **June 30th**.
